


- A Learning Support Classroom and teacher to better support our diverse learners

- Continue Monthly Student Support Team Meetings focused on student well-being learning, and attendance










High School Completion Rates






TroVal students continue to perform well on their PATs. We will continue to support students' literacy growth through ELI and LLI programming, library time, classroom libraries, Buddy Reading and our Birthday Book program.

Operating Budget

98% of TroVal's yearly budget is allocated to staffing. This ensures that nearly 100% of our available resources stay in the classroom, in the form of people power, with TroVal students.



Facilities and Capital Plan

- 1. Create a sensory space designed for soothing and relaxation as well as for teaching the skills of self-calming and self-regulation. Creating a school that is truly inclusive starts in each classroom, but it must also be wider in scope. It requires specific strategies and a shift in culture that is shared and encouraged by the school administration, teachers, and students of Trochu Valley School.
- 2. We will continue to work on grounds beautification and creating outdoor seating. This will provide the flexibility to take student learning outside the walls of the classroom. This outdoor classroom will be a nice addition to our other outdoor learning spaces; our school greenhouse and school vegetable garden.
- 3. Build an outdoor storage shed with a partnership between our Industrial Education students and our local tradespeople. This will create an opportunity for career exploration for our students and a valuable storage space for our school.
