GUIDANCE AND COUNSELLING SERVICES

Background

Guidance and counseling services shall be available to all students as an integral part of school programs and services.

Procedures

- 1. Comprehensive school guidance and counseling programs shall address the developmental needs of all students in the three domains:
 - 1.1 Career planning and development;
 - 1.2 Personal / social issues; and
 - 1.3 Educational planning.
- 2. Guidance and counseling service delivery shall be a collaborative, multi-disciplinary task that involves all members of the school staff, not solely the school counselor.
- 3. Service shall be consistent with Alberta Education Policy 1.6.3.
