SCHOOL LIBRARIES

Background

Students must have access to an effective school library program integrated with instructional programs to provide improved opportunities for student achievement.

Procedures

- 1. The Principal and school staff shall plan for resource-based learning which integrates the school library program with the instructional program of the school
- 2. The Principal and school staff shall provide input into budget, priorities, selection of resources, and development of a library handbook.
- 3. Schools shall have written selection criteria for the purchase of library resources which are consistent with:
 - 3.1 Guidelines for tolerance and understanding
 - 3.2 The 'Controversial Issues' section of the Guide to Education
 - 3.3 Canadian content priorities
 - 3.4 Identified library program goal and objectives
 - 3.5 Needs identified by students and teachers
 - 3.6 Information from recognized selection tools
 - 3.7 Resource-based learning
- 4. Each school's library handbook shall include goals and objectives for the library program, purchasing plan, instructional plan, culling procedures and a long range budget.
