## **RELIGIOUS OBSERVANCES AND INSTRUCTION**

## **Background**

Religious observances and instruction have a place in public school education, but only insofar as they are non-proselytizing and non-compulsory.

## **Procedures**

- 1. The Lord's Prayer and short uninterpreted readings from the Bible are considered to be appropriate for day opening exercises.
- 2. Christmas Carols and other seasonal activities that have a religious base are acceptable.
- 3. All requests for religious observances and instruction, beyond those listed in 1 and 2 above, shall be referred to the Superintendent for approval.
- 4. Parents will be informed when students are to be involved in religious observances.
- 5. It shall be made clear to parents and students that any student may abstain and/or be absent from an activity with religious overtones, for reasons of belief.
