

STUDENT PERFORMANCE BONDS

Background

The Division believes that high school students must be held accountable for their learning through performance bonds, when taking a course in which they have previously enrolled.

Procedures

1. At the discretion of the Principal, students will be required to provide a performance bond amounting to \$25.00 per credit for courses (e.g., \$125.00 for a five (5) credit course) which they have:
 - Failed and are repeating;
 - From which they have withdrawn, or
 - Which they are repeating to upgrade their mark.
2. Upon the successful completion of the course, the full amount of the performance bond will be refunded.
3. Exceptions may be made when deemed necessary by the Principal in cases of economic hardship, or other extenuating circumstances.
