## STUDENT PERFORMANCE BONDS

## **Background**

The Division believes that high school students must be held accountable for their learning through performance bonds, when taking a course in which they have previously enrolled.

## **Procedures**

1. At the discretion of the Principal, students will be required to provide a performance bond amounting to \$25.00 per credit for courses (e.g., \$125.00 for a five (5) credit course) which they have:

Failed and are repeating;

From which they have withdrawn, or

Which they are repeating to upgrade their mark.

- 2. Upon the successful completion of the course, the full amount of the performance bond will be refunded.
- 3. Exceptions may be made when deemed necessary by the Principal in cases of economic hardship, or other extenuating circumstances.
