ROLE OF THE DIRECTOR OF FACILITIES

Background

The Director of Facilities oversees and plans for the physical maintenance and upgrading of Division facilities.

Procedures

The Director of Facilities shall:

- 1. Develop and implement procedures that will ensure clean, safe facilities.
- 2. Develop a department budget for consideration in the Division's annual budget.
- 3. Oversee the activities of the maintenance and caretaking staff.
- 4. Oversee the work of the caretaking staff in consultation with the school Principal.
- 5. Administer and control the annual budget allotment to maintenance and caretaking.
- 6. Assist the Secretary-Treasurer in the preparation of the three-year Capital Plan and a Facilities Master Plan.

PROCEDURE DATED: February, 2006

- 7. Assist the Secretary-Treasurer in the preparation of an annual IMP.
- 8. Carry out such other duties as may be assigned from time to time by the Secretary Treasurer.
