Other Points to Consider

- Grid Movement approximately \$520K
- 60% of teachers are at top of the grid
- Online learning up more than funding
- Transportation & Operations & Maintenance fully funded
 - Flexibility to move to instruction from O & M
- Reserves capped at \$68M by Government we are proposing to use \$1.2M all site based allocations

What's Next?

- Finalize and submit to Alberta Education by May 31, 2020
- Re-open budget software (MBF) for Administrators and Managers to make adjustments as needed
- Once September 30th frozen headcount has been finalized, update MBF
- Review Budgets
- Export from budget software to accounting software so Administrators/Managers can monitor their budgets
